Grief Groups Offered

Grief Group A

Death of Partner- A group for the spouse whose partners have died.

Death of a parent, sibling, or other significant relationship – A group is for families’ members whose parents, siblings, or other significant family/friends have died.

Death of Child under 18- A group for parents dealing with the death of a child under age 18.

Death of Child over 18- A group for parents dealing with the death of a child over age 18.

Teen Group- For Teens whose loved one died, ages 13+

Child 3- For children whose loved one died, ages 10-12

Child 2- For children whose loved one died, ages 6-9

Child 1- For children whose loved one died, ages 3-5

Virtual Support Group A- A group for those anticipating the death of their loved one or their loved one has died

Grief Group B

Death of a parent, sibling, or other significant relationship – A group is for families’ members whose parents, siblings, or other significant family/friends have died.

Suicide Loss Grief group- for those whose loved one’s died by suicide.

Miscarriage, and infant loss - A group for parents who have child loss through miscarriage, stillbirth, and infertility.

Homicide Loss – for those whose loved one’s died by homicide.

Teen Group- For Teens whose loved one died, ages 13+

Child 3- For children whose loved one died, ages 10-12

Child 2- For children whose loved one died, ages 6-9

Child 1- For children whose loved one died, ages 3-5

Virtual Support Group B- A group for those anticipating the death of their loved one or their loved one has died
