Grief Groups Offered

Grief Group A

Death of a parent, sibling, or other significant relationship – A group for individuals whose parents, siblings, or other significant family/friends have died.

Death of Spouse/Partner - A group for those whose spouse/partner has died.

Suicide Loss Grief group- for those whose loved one has died by suicide.

Teen Group- For Teens whose loved one died, ages 13+

Child 3- For children whose loved one died, ages 10-12

Child 2- For children whose loved one died, ages 6-9

Child 1- For children whose loved one died, ages 3-5

Grief Group B

Death of a parent, sibling, or other significant relationship – A group for individuals whose parents, siblings, or other significant family/friends have died.

Death of Child and Reproductive Loss- A group for parents dealing with the death of a child and for those who have experienced miscarriage, infertility, and stillbirth.

Virtual Support Group- A group for adults anticipating the death of their loved one or their loved one has died.

Teen Group- For Teens whose loved one died, ages 13+

Child 3- For children whose loved one died, ages 10-12

Child 2- For children whose loved one died, ages 6-9

Child 1- For children whose loved one died, ages 3-5
