Grief Group A

Parent/Sibling/Other Significant Relationship – A group for adults dealing with the death of a parent, sibling, or other significant family/friend.

Spouse/partner loss under 55 – A group for those whose spouse/partner has died under age 55.

Spouse/partner loss over 55 – A group for those whose spouse/partner has died after age 55.

Suicide loss – A group for adults whose loved one died by suicide.

Traumatic Loss – A group for adults who have had a loved one die in a traumatic way (e.g. sudden accident, overdose, homicide, etc.)

Child 1 – A group for children ages 3-5 whose loved one died.

Child 2 – A group for children ages 6-9 whose loved one died.

Child 3 - A group for children ages 10-12 whose loved one died.

Teen – A group for teens whose loved one died.

Grief Group B

Parent/Sibling/Other Significant Relationship – A group for adults dealing with the death of a parent, sibling, or other significant family/friend.

Child loss under 18 – A group for those whose child died under age 18.

Child loss over 18 – A group for those whose child died over age 18.

Reproductive loss – A group for those who have a child loss through miscarriage, stillbirth, or infertility.

Virtual Support Group — A group for adults anticipating the death of their loved one or whose loved one has died. This group meets via zoom.

Child 1 – A group for children ages 3-5 whose loved one died.

Child 2 – A group for children ages 6-9 whose loved one died.

Child 3 - A group for children ages 10-12 whose loved one died.

Teen – A group for teens whose loved one died.
